The following is a suggested supply list for each grade for the first day of school.
St. Paul's will provide Homework Assignment books.

- **Please label all personal items with your child's or family name** (sweatshirts, water bottles, lunch containers, folders, etc.). We find too many unreturnable items in Lost & Found due to no names on them.

- Please do not send permanent nor scented markers for any class.
- Every student needs to bring a reusable water bottle labeled with name and homeroom.

FIRST GRADE

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Label **all** personal items with your child's name (supplies, lunch bags, water bottles, etc.)

- ☐ A dual-pocket folder with child's name on the front
 - Please no file folders, envelope folders, prong folders, etc.
- ☐ 1 wide-ruled composition notebook with child's name on front for Homeroom
- ☐ 1 pair of small scissors (with child's name on it)
- ☐ 1 set of 8-count, washable, **thick**, classic-colored Crayola markers or similar brand (Keep them inside their box and not labeled. These are for the class set.)
- ☐ 1 pair of earbuds OR headphones (**NO** WiFi-capable earbuds such as AirPods):

- ☐ 1 large, zippered pencil bag to hold supplies (with child's name on it). Please do NOT purchase the pencil pack that can unzip completely until it's just a zipper (looks like a fun monster); students end up playing with it like a toy.
- ☐ 1 box crayons (24 count – no more!)
 - No scented, fluorescent, sparkly or twist-up crayons
- ☐ 4 glue sticks
- ☐ 2 plain erasers
- ☐ 5 sharpened pencils (we encourage using the Treesmart pencils made out of recycled newspaper)
- ☐ Sunscreen stick
- ☐ Hat
- ☐ 1 backpack large enough to fit a folder, lunch box/plate, snacks, sweatshirt, water bottle, and anything else your child may bring (**NO** roller backpacks, please)
- ☐ 2 small snack containers. (Please review with your child that the containers holding snacks will be for recess and an afternoon snack break. It's helpful if they are separated from the lunch). These are ideal:
