Subject: Solidarity and Assistance in Response to Beirut Explosion

Your Eminence/Excellency:

It is with great concern for our brothers and sisters in Beirut, Lebanon, that I connect with you today. Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of those impacted by the tragic explosion there that killed so many without warning last week. As Bishop Malloy and I said in our joint statement, the suffering has only begun to be told.

Our brothers Bishops Gregory Mansour and Elias Zaidan have spoken passionately and eloquently on the needs of the people of Lebanon at this time. They encourage us to respond by prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and advocacy. Please read <u>their encouraging words</u> and consider how you might respond.

If you choose to offer assistance to join in response efforts, donations can be made to Catholic Relief Services.

We continue to join the Holy Father's <u>prayer</u> that Lebanon may "overcome the grave crisis they are experiencing" and implore the intercession of Our Lady of Lebanon to bring peace, comfort, and strength to all in need of those graces.
