



Small Essentials, Big Impact

The Sutter County Children & Families Commission (SCCFC) administers a variety of programs and services to support children ages 0–5 and their families. These services focus on strengthening families, improving early childhood outcomes, and addressing gaps in systems of care.

In 2025, SCCFC recognized diaper needs as a significant contributor to family stress and poverty and identified a critical gap in access to basic hygiene supports for Sutter County families. With assistance from Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds from Sutter County Community Action Agency, SCCFC successfully launched the Sutter County Diaper Bank.

Rather than creating a traditional eligibility-restricted program, SCCFC leveraged a community partnership with Hope Point Church’s Diaper Bank to expand access to families who are often excluded from other funding streams. This partnership allowed both organizations to maximize reach and reduce duplication of services.



The Diaper Bank enhanced SCCFC’s service delivery by providing immediate, tangible support while also connecting families to additional resources like their Car Seat Education Program, Mothers & Babies Group and more, improving the overall impact for individuals, families, and the broader community.



The program has demonstrated a significant impact on Sutter County families. In 2025, a total of 491 individuals were served through the program. The program continues to see strong success in 2026, with 112 unduplicated households, representing 461 individuals, served as of May 26, 2026. As of 2026 to date, approximately 23,600 diapers and 59,000 baby wipes have been distributed to eligible Sutter County families.

Diaper and wipe distributions for Sutter County families are held on the 4th Friday of each month from 10:00am -11:00am at Hope Point Church, 600 N. George Washington Blvd, Yuba City. The next distribution will be June 26th, pre-registration is encouraged.
