REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR DAGWAAGI CEREMONY FEAST

Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is seeking proposals through solicitation for meal preparation and clean up for the **Dagwaagi Ceremony Feast**, which is scheduled for **Monday, September 23, 2019**. This event will take place at the **Bad River Community Center** beginning at 4:30 p.m. for approximately **175 adults and youth**. It is the responsibility of the bidder to prepare and set-up the meal as well as clean-up after the meal.

Proposals are required to contain the following information: Total cost for catering. Bids must include a break down.

The duty details should include but is not limited to:

- The cook and her/his helpers fees;
- This includes preparing and providing the food items;
- You will be responsible to obtain all the preparation (knives, etc.), cooking (pots & pans, etc.) and cleaning products
- You will be responsible for cleaning up the food tables and any other area that were used to store or prepare any and all food products;
- The meal must be ready and on the food tables no later than 5:30 p.m.

All Food Products, Donations and Paper products (plates, cups, eating utensils, napkins, tablecloths and storage bags) will be provided through donation or other options and are NOT the responsibility or property of the caterers.

The Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, U.S.C. Section 476. This entitles the Tribe to government pricing and exempts the Tribe from state sales and use taxes and from federal excise taxes. Therefore, price quotations should not include such taxes.

This Request for Proposals is open to all qualified, responsive bidders. Indian Preference will apply in the selection process in accordance with the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) or the Indian Preference Act of 1934 (Title 25, USC, Section 47), based on funding source requirements. Questions regarding TERO, and if the TERO fee applies to the RFP, may be directed to the Bad River Band's Human Resource office at 715-682-7111.
