Weather Delay Procedure Change: 90 Minute Delays

Effective 2018-2019 school year: CCNS will be making a change to weather delays. CCNS currently follows the Talawanda School District's weather procedures- unless there is a 90 minute delay, CCNS has closed for these delays in the past.

The CCNS Board has voted via email that starting the 2018-2019 school year, we will follow the EXACT Talawanda School District Snow & Weather Procedures. If TSD closes, CCNS will also close. If TSD enforces a 90 minute delay, CCNS will also follow the 90 minute delay. Class will begin at 10:30 (the preschool door will opened at 10:25 a.m.) and end at regular time (11:45 a.m.). Due to the shortened time, a 90 minute delay class schedule will not include a snack time.
