About This Project

IMPROVEMENTS

Further to the Region's last communication on July 23, 2018, this letter provides an update to the planned construction works on Truman Street, Ward 2, in the City of Burlington. As previously noted, Halton Region is planning to install a new 300 mm watermain along Truman Street, from Churchill Avenue to 70 m north of Churchill Avenue in the City of Burlington. The project also includes the removal of the existing watermain along the Hydro One corridor easement, from Brant Street (Reg. Rd. 18) to 90 m east of Truman Street (see attached map for project limits). This work is required to maintain dependable access to clean drinking water for the community.

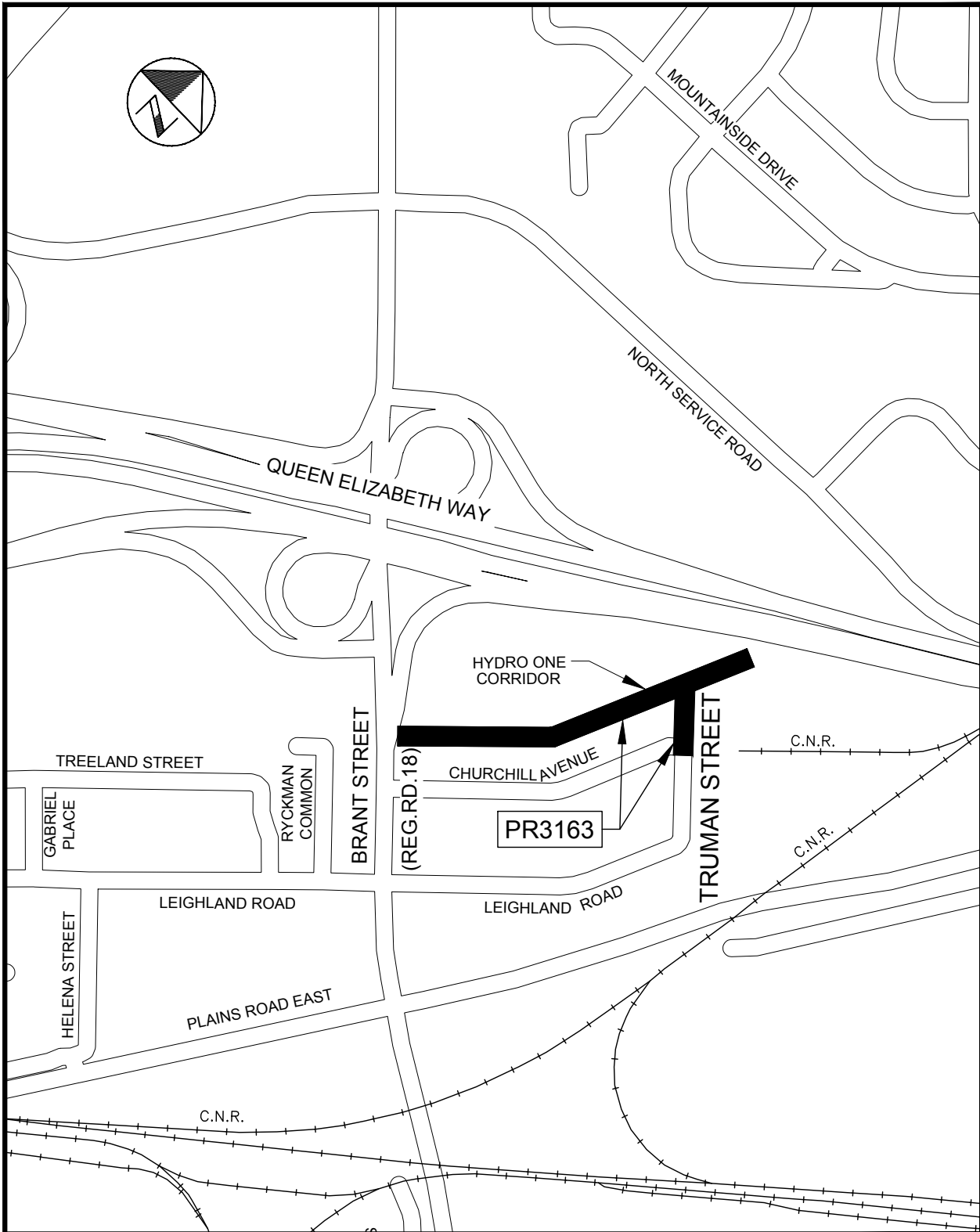
As a project update, the design has been completed, the applicable permits have been acquired and the project is currently being tendered. Construction is now tentatively scheduled to begin in winter/spring 2020. A more detailed notice will be distributed once the contract is awarded and the construction schedule is confirmed.
