Perfect Reach

Four strategic lengths work as a progression system: Start with the 12" for tight spaces and precision work, move to the 16" workhorse for standard repairs, deploy the versatile 16.5" multi-head when techniques change, and finish with the 19" when expansive roofs and hoods demand maximum reach. No more awkward angles, no forcing, just controlled precision. TECH TIP: Position yourself to 'read the reflection' then combine a hammer with an optional PDR rod. Perfect view and position to push the lows from the back and tap the highs.

Surface Versatility

Dual rigid/soft tips on the 12" and 16" models handle both panel blending and knock-down work. Use the leather pad on the head when precision tapping a knock-down tool. Switch to the 16.5" Multi-Head system adds 9+ interchangeable tips for material-specific or technique-specific demands. From initial metal manipulation to final delicate finishing, you'll have the exact surface contact the repair requires.

Ergonomic Ball Grip

Transform how you work with the ingenious counter-balanced ball grip design. Gripping by the ball end alone reduces hammer impact for firm but controlled soft blows, perfect for delicate finishing work. The ergonomic shape sits comfortably in your hand during extended sessions while simultaneously maximizing your reach capabilities when you need every inch. One grip design, multiple techniques, all-day comfort.
