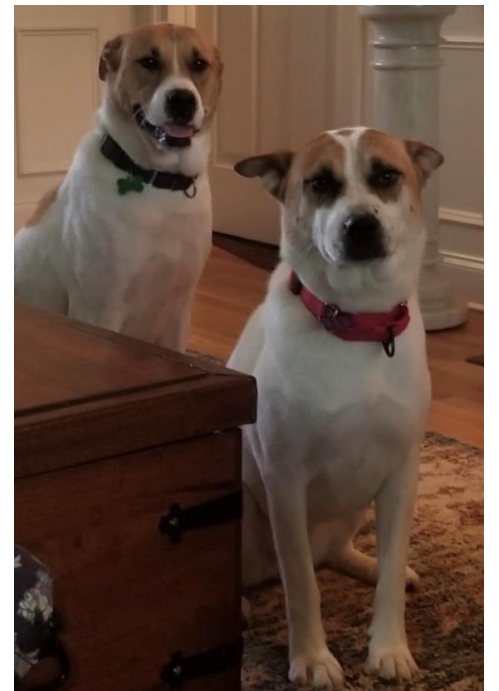


Leesel and Brooklyn
