

FREE Basic Construction Methods & Operations Training

Thanks to a grant provided by the Northampton County Department of Economic Development, Northampton Community College will be providing **FREE** training to enhance the skills of current home construction employees or prepare new employees for employment. The program will include hands on instruction in basic construction methods and operations, including:

- hand and power tools
- framing and applications of trim
- · drywall and wall repairs
- · door and window installation
- · ladder and scaffolding safety
- building code awareness

Candidates successfully completing the program will earn an OSHA 10-Hour Outreach Training for Construction card. An employer day will also be included so participants will have the opportunity to network and interview with potential employers.
