



FREE Basic Construction Methods & Operations Training

The program will include hands on instruction in basic construction methods and operations, including:

- hand and power tools
- framing and applications of trim
- drywall and wall repairs
- door and window installation
- ladder and scaffolding safety
- building code awareness

Candidates successfully completing the program will earn an OSHA 10-Hour Outreach Training for Construction card. An employer day will also be included so participants will have the opportunity to network and interview with potential employers.

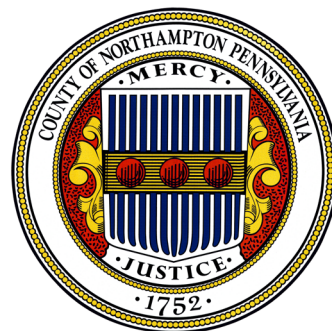
