COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions February 22, 2022

Q: With COVID-19 cases not soaring as much, when will we be able to eat inside the building again? Running back and forth to our vehicles takes time away from our lunch and with the weather getting warmer, we are inclined to eat in the car with our AC.

From the COVID-19 Response Team

- A: Now that we are in surge 1 again, people can resume or feel comfortable utilizing indoor breakrooms for lunches and breaks. We continue to require that staff follow safe environment precautions with six-foot distancing, frequent hand hygiene, and mask use when not eating or drinking.
- Q: What is the current status of any program/department in the organization planning and wanting to host an event that could potentially bring in a lot of people? I am concerned knowing we are still in a pandemic and upper management wanting to have an event.

From the COVID-19 Response Team

A: All events that are held at AltaMed are still recommended to follow safe environment recommendations of six-foot distancing, frequent hand hygiene, cleaning high touch surfaces before and after events, and mandatory mask use at all times. We discourage gatherings indoors if food or beverages will be served indoors as this will encourage people to be without their masks for extended periods of time.
