Q: I reviewed the Face Masking Policy (#HR-WEL-007) and am uncertain about employees in Corporate offices sitting in cubicles. Can you confirm the masking policy for employees working in Corporate cubicles? Is working in a cubicle deemed an isolated workplace and, therefore, an exception to masking?

A: Cubicles are considered shared spaces and therefore one needs to wear their mask at all times while sitting in a cubicle, unless taking it off briefly to take a sip of something or eat food. Private office spaces with doors closed are the only environments where you are able to sit with your mask off while alone in the office.
