

8th Grade Final Exam Schedule S2; 2025

Students should return textbooks on the days of their final exams.

Friday, May 2nd

8th Grade Dance. CRHS Gym. 7-9. Please drop off and pick up your student at the main entrance of the building (Door 1 by the flag poles).

Monday, May 12th

Last day to submit missing/late work.

Tuesday, May 20

Students will attend their B1 & B2 classes and then attend their **8th grade picnic.**
