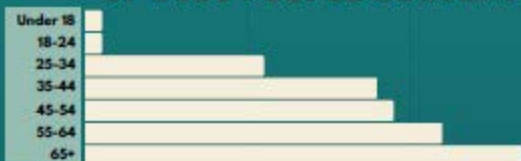




MARICOPA COUNTY COMMUNITY TESTING

We've partnered with healthcare providers and nonprofit organizations to bring **COVID-19** testing to our communities. Here is what we've learned from listening to our residents:

OF 1500 PEOPLE SURVEYED:



AGE OF THOSE
WHO RESPONDED:

36% WERE TESTED

63% WERE NOT TESTED

BETWEEN AUG 1 - OCT 31, 2020



TOP REASONS WHY PEOPLE DID GET TESTED

- 20%** I had symptoms of COVID-19
- 10%** I was exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms
- 8%** I had no symptoms but was curious if I had COVID-19
- 8%** Testing was available at work
- 7%** I knew there were many COVID-19 cases locally
- 7%** I was exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19

OTHER REASONS WHY PEOPLE GOT TESTED

24%
CHOSE "OTHER"

- 212 people answered "Testing was free"
- 140 people answered "Testing was easy to find"
- 40+ people answered "Required for Medical Procedure"
- 13+ answered "Travel"

TOP REASONS WHY PEOPLE DID NOT GET TESTED

- 58%** I never had symptoms
- 18%** I was never exposed to someone with COVID-19
- 4%** I don't think the test results are accurate
- 2%** I didn't want to get a nasal swab
- 2%** I didn't know where to get a test

OTHER REASONS WHY PEOPLE DID NOT GET TESTED

More than 20 people responded that they had either already been tested, or had already gotten Covid-19

- Results wouldn't change anything
- My freedom to decide
- Don't want to risk going out
- Don't trust accuracy
- Testing is useless without contact tracing
- I feel healthy and do not want to skew the numbers
- There is no cure or treatment, so testing doesn't do any good
- Was told to only get tested if I had symptoms
- I was denied testing because I no symptoms
- Too much conflicting information
- Testing just to be tested is costly and unnecessary
- I heard on TV it wasn't important to get a test and to just stay home
