



# RICOPA COL **COMMUNITY TESTING**

We've partnered with healthcare providers and nonprofit organizations to bring COVID-19 testing to our communities.

Here is what we've learned from listening to our residents: OF 1500 PEOPLE SURVEYED:











## TOP REASONS WHY PEOPLE DID GET TESTED

20% I had symptoms of COVID-19

10% I was exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms 8% I had no symptoms but was curious if I had COVID-19

8% Testing was available at work

7% I knew there were many COVID-19 cases locally 7% I was exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19



212 people answered "Testing was free"
140 people answered "Testing was easy to find"
40+ people answered "Required for Medical Procedure"
13+ answered "Travel"

## TOP REASONS WHY PEOPLE DID NOT GET TESTED

58% Ineverhad symptoms

18% I was never exposed to some one with COVID-19 I don't think the test results are accurate

2% I didn't want to get a nasal swab

I didn't know where to get a test

#### More than 20 people responded that they had either already been tested,

or had already gotten Covid-19
