

Construction Science Pre-Apprentice Classroom Program Outline

Program Requirements

- Must have reliable transportation
- Pass drug and alcohol testing
- Pass a basic background check
- Be 18 Years of Age and older
- Must be WIOA Eligible
- Ability to lift, bend, squat, and work in ALL Arizona weather conditions
- Work will include the use of hand tools and small equipment
- Be on time and attend all day

Program Structure

PHASE 1: Week One Class Training

The 1-week program will provide you with tools to prepare you for the construction industry. A detailed list of the days is on page two of this document.

PHASE 2: Week two through Week Nine will Provide You with Hands-on Work Experience

After completing the 1-week training, you will begin working with a local company that will provide hands-on learning opportunities. During this training, participants will be paid \$15.00 per hour.

Classroom Training

Day 1

- Initial paperwork, registration in NCCER, and expectations.
Orientation to the program, participating company information (expectations), and career paths within each organization.

Day 2

- *First half of the day is a field trip to a job site or location where they are exposed to real working conditions*
- First Impressions-Getting a Job
- Professionalism-Keeping your Job
- Teamwork-Getting Along with Your Co-Workers

Day 3

- Building a Strong Relationship with Your Supervisor
- Giving and Receiving Criticism
- Managing Stress on the Job
- Resolving Conflict
- Thinking Critically and Solving Problems

Day 4

- Diversity in the Workplace
- Sexual Harassment
- Substance Abuse
- Introduction to Construction Math
Reviews basic math skills related to the construction trades and demonstrates how they apply to the trades. Covers multiple systems of measurement, decimals, fractions, and basic geometry.

- Introduction to Construction Math (continued)
