Presenter: Dr. Siguna Mueller

Last week, we had the pleasure of listening to Dr. Siguna Mueller.

Dr. Siguna Mueller is an experienced independent transdisciplinary researcher who spent the first 20 years of her academic career in mathematics. She has a Masters in Mathematics/Statistics (with highest distinction, University of Klagenfurt, Austria), a PhD in Mathematics (summa cum laude, Univ. of Klagenfurt), and was among the first women in Austria to receive the Habilitation in Discrete Mathematics and Cryptography (2002).

The following 15 years Dr. Mueller spent as a Research Associate at the Centre for Information Security and Cryptography Research, University of Calgary, and as Assistant Professor at the University of Wyoming. She had a lifelong passion for biology and medicine that eventually triggered her decision to radically expand her field of expertise. Consequently, she earned her second PhD in Biomedical Sciences (GPA of 4.0) in 2014 at the University of Wyoming.



Since then, Dr. Mueller has been utilizing her experience in the theoretical fields to help advance a broader appreciation and comprehension of phenomena and challenges arising in the biological and life science domains. Her work and interests are not limited to those fields as she finds great enjoyment in physics, theology, philosophy, ethics, spirituality, and the complexity of nature altogether.

Dr. Mueller has been a member of The European Network of Scientists for Social and Environmental Responsibility (ENSSER) since 2020, has been a volunteer contributor to several open-ended online Forums of the Convention on Biological Diversity, and is the author of “Challenges and Opportunities of mRNA Vaccines Against SARS-CoV-2—A Multidisciplinary Perspective”, published by Springer in 2023.
