Examples could be purchase of technology or remote access equipment need to support remote work, offset of employer costs associated with additional/non-traditional work shifts required to accommodate social distancing and government capacity limitations, costs associated with implementing social distancing protections, training costs, etc.

Projects can include a company or group of companies leveraging efforts for their industry or shared need. If a cohort of companies accessing resources, the applicant below will be the recipient responsible for coordinating efforts amongst the group. **Please note that these funds cannot pay for wage-replacement. Applications will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.** Once the application is approved, funds are available immediately. Funds will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
