

AH Then & Now – 170 Sigourney St



In 2002, 170 Sigourney St was the address for the Christ Temple Church of God in Christ. They had purchased the building from the owner who had been leasing it to the State Department of Children and Families. When that division moved, it sat empty for several years before the Church bought it.

The story of how it then came into the possession of the Asylum Hill Boys & Girls Club Development Committee who oversaw the construction, while truly interesting is much longer than this space allows.

Suffice it to say what was a troubled property became both the 4th Boys & Girls Club for Hartford, and the offices of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Hartford who are now completing construction of their 5th club in the Southend of Hartford. In the 15 years since the club at 170 Sigourney was built, thousands of children and families not to mention the Asylum Hill community have benefitted immeasurably.
