

Asylum Hill Then & Now 256 S. Marshall

This photo, from the Hartford History Center of the Hartford Public Library's City Parks Collection shows a stately masonry church of considerable size at the corner of Case and South Marshall St. It was the Catholic Apostolic Church and had moved to this location from Broad St in 1911 to join the Asylum Hill Congregational Church, Farmington Avenue Congregational Church (later to become Immanuel), Asylum Avenue Baptist Church, Trinity Episcopal Church and St. Joseph Cathedral in Asylum Hill all familiar landmarks as well as the Church of the Redeemer Universalist (next month's column). The story of how such a beautiful church could be replaced by this apartment building which was built in 1964 would require much more space than available here.
