

AH Then & Now - Woodland St at Asylum Ave



This photo is from the Library of Congress and beneath it is the caption “Woodland Street – looking north from Asylum Avenue One of Hartford’s most charming residential streets.” With a column of what look like elm trees on the right side and a little bit of the Goodwin estate which accounted for most of the western side of Woodland St left, we can only imagine the dozen other beautiful homes that lined this street. According to the 1921 map of Hartford their were more than a dozen on both sides of Woodland all the way to Sargeant St.
