

## Healing Arts Exhibit – Jane Carroll Watercolors “Another Spring”

It's been a few years since we featured the Integrative Medicine Center at Saint Francis, but we have a special reason this month. They have on display 21 watercolor paintings by Asylum Hill resident, Jane Carroll. Her connection to Saint Francis and watercolor painting goes back to 2006

when she received a diagnosis of myeloma, and began treatment for it at Saint Francis. After successful treatment and a year of remission she decided to take up watercolor painting with the “new life” that she had been given.

Since then she has had ten more years in which to study, paint and live.

This past year the myeloma returned, and so did she to Saint Francis and the Integrative Medicine Center.

Once again she is feeling strong and back to painting,

and the works on display on the walls of the Center are a testament to the healing powers there.

The Exhibit titled “Another Spring” which was her hope ten years ago and again today, has been on display since May 14<sup>th</sup>, and will continue until July 6<sup>th</sup>. The best time to view it will be at the Reception to meet the Artist on Wednesday, June 13<sup>th</sup> from 4:30 – 6:30 pm.
