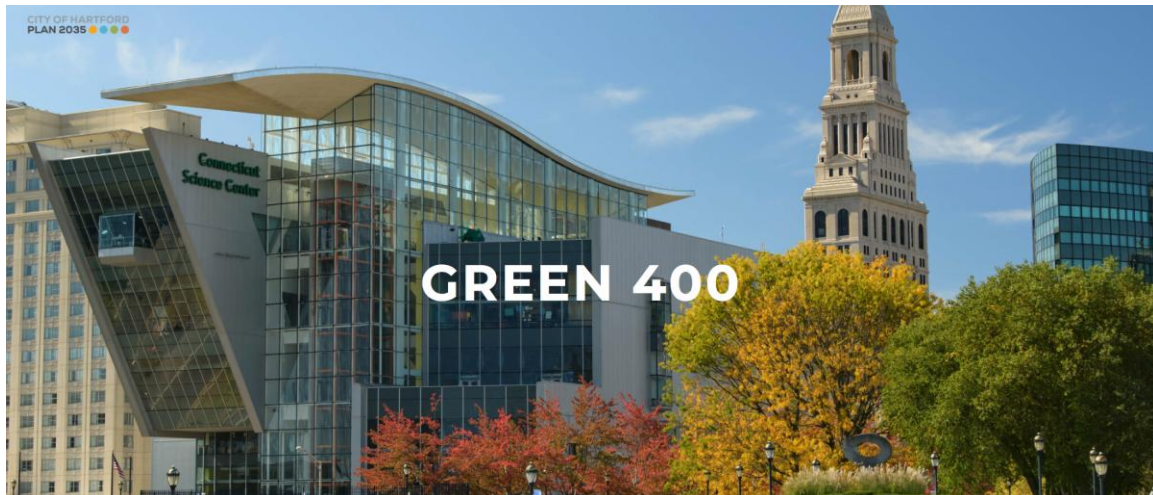


Hartford 400 begins with AHNA



Every ten years Hartford creates a plan to guide the City's progress for the next decade. In 2010 the plan was called "**One City One Plan**". The City is now embarking on a new plan for the next decade and beyond, especially since Hartford will turn 400 years old in 2035. Efforts have been underway for more than a year, laying the groundwork for this plan, and March will be the month of public meetings to discover, understand and contribute to this effort.
