

Exploring Asylum Hill – 86-88 Hawthorn St

If you haven't been by the corner of S. Marshall and Hawthorn lately, then you won't know about the big hole in the ground where for many years there was only an empty parking lot. It is the beginning of what will be NINAs largest residential project to date.



What began in the Northeast corner of Asylum Hill 15 years ago to improve the neighborhood through owner occupancy has now reached the Southwest end of Asylum Hill. The rendering shows the side-by-side townhouses that will be the first of two buildings and four homes in the area. Combined with the Habitat for Humanity and CIL developments in the area, and it will bring the total number of new owner occupied homes in the last 10 years to 33.

While these properties won't be available for a while, the NINA home at 115 Sigourney St (shown below) is nearing completion, and will be part of the Asylum Hill/West End portion of the Hartford Blooms tour on June 1st.
