Queridos Amigas y Amigos,

Our Solar Saves Lives in Puerto Rico Committee has joined national efforts to solarize Puerto Rico. We are asking your help, so together, we can save lives!

In the fall of 2017, hurricanes Maria and Irma swept across Puerto Rico. Still a year later, many remain in urgent need of power. Connecticut has strong ties with Puerto Rico, being the state with the highest Puerto Rican population in our mainland. Our numbers have increased after the hurricanes, with many Puerto Rican families finding shelter in our state.

As we support families who arrive in Connecticut seeking help, we also want to join with those who are preparing for future hurricanes. To that end, we are working with the Solar Foundation's initiative, **Solar Saves Lives**. Their goal is to install solar and battery systems in 60 health clinics throughout the island, ensuring they will continue meeting critical needs even when the power grid goes down. Six clinics are completed.

So, on November 16, our Committee will be holding a "Solar Saves Lives in Puerto Rico" Fiesta, at Immanuel Congregational Church, 10 Woodland St in Hartford CT from 6:30-9:00 PM. We'll have Puerto Rican food, hispanic music, an art show, inspirational speakers and solar exhibits.
