

CDC Guidelines on Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes ATM screen, keypads, cabinet doors and handles, lock mechanisms.
- If surfaces are dirty, clean them. Use disinfectants which are appropriate for the surface, such as:
 - Diluting your household bleach
 - 5 tablespoons (1/3 cup) bleach per gallon of water
 - 4 teaspoons bleach per quart of water
 - Follow manufacturer's instructions for application and proper ventilation. Check to ensure the product is not past its expiration date. Never mix household bleach with ammonia or any other cleanser. Unexpired household bleach will be effective against coronaviruses when properly diluted.
 - Alcohol solutions – ensure the solution contains at least 70% alcohol.
 - Other common EPA-registered household disinfectants.
 - Products with [EPA-approved emerging viral pathogens](#) claims are expected to be effective against COVID-19 based on data for harder to kill viruses. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for all cleaning and disinfection products (e.g., concentration, application method and contact time, etc.)
