**Please bring the following materials...**

**6 sunflower and 6 pumpkin seeds, coronas out of 1 small and 1 medium foraged acorn caps,  
and pistils and stamens out of 5-10 dried rosemary leaf pieces from a garden or spice cabinet.  
1 tube of 'No Run Gel' Crazy Glue. 1 can of white, yellow, silver or gold spray paint, designer's  
choice. Several fingernail polishes, that have daffodil colors to complement your base spray  
paint choice. And 1 clear fingernail polish for a topcoat.  
1 paper towel, 1 wooden skewer.**
