The 2022 Western Regional Herding trials enjoyed another solid financial performance. This event has been steadily growing in profitability since 2017. This was the only Regional Herding event in 2022.

In summary, the Western Regional, under the guidance of Linda Ward, had a gain of \$146.85. This is a reduction from prior years driven by the need this year to buy new ribbons/rosettes versus using up unused rosette inventory from prior years. 2021 had a gain of \$1,326.20 versus a gain of \$1,187.78 in 2020, \$441.57 in 2019, \$654.88 in 2018 and \$388.86 in 2017.
