Constitution - Article II, Section 5 If a membership has been terminated by lapsing, the membership is entitled to reinstatement for a period of one (1) year (before December 15 of the following year) which will require the payment of a reinstatement fee, submittal of a reinstatement form, and the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the Voting Directors present at a meeting where a quorum is present. Once a membership has been lapsed for one (1) year, (after December 15th of the following year), the lapsed member shall not be entitled to reinstatement and must formally apply for membership as a new member in accordance with Section 3 of this Article.
