Outstanding Local Collie Club Awards:

The following Proposal is in two parts:

- 1) To establish the Outstanding Local Collie Club Awards.
- 2) To furnish financial support for the Outstanding Local Collie Club Awards

The Public Relations Committee proposes to add the Outstanding Local Collie Club Award to be given annually by the Collie Club of America. The purpose of the awards is to encourage the promotion of the collie, the local collie club, and the Collie Club of America. Two local collie clubs are to be honored for outstanding collie promotion for the year. The two awards will be given by tiers based on membership.

Collie Club of America has supported the amount of \$500.00 each, a total of \$1,000.00, annually for the "Meet the Breed" events in New York and Orlando, FL Collie promotion and the Collie Club of America are well supported at these events. These events are indeed supported, however, increasing the possible geographic support would make it conceivable for other areas to benefit by monetary means in collie promotion. An unsung way in which the Collie Club of America has in collie promotion and support for the Collie Club of America is the local collie clubs throughout the country. We submit the request that the Collie Club of America would support and honor local collie clubs by contributing \$500.00 award annually for each of two (2) local collie clubs that are doing a great job in this promotion. With the current environment that we have, we have an opportunity as a purebred parent club to lead in awarding our own for an outstanding job in collie promotion. In reality, the local collie clubs are our best resource in collie promotion. Coming off of a couple of years' stent of decrease socialization, we can be forthright in the elevation of the collie.

Outcome expected:

- Great collie promotion to the public
- Growth in local collie clubs, with reflective growth in CCA membership.
- Cash award that can be used to assist the local collie club in further collie promotion.
- Enthusiasm within the local collie clubs in working toward collie promotion goals and being recognized and awarded for their work.

The Public Relations Committee is requesting the annual grant of \$1,000.00 for \$500.00 awarded for each tier based on the club's membership size and resources. Two tiers are planned with viewing membership size of clubs at the following:

Tier 1: Clubs with memberships of 25 or less

Tier 2: Clubs with memberships more than 25
