

Doing Business with the State of Arkansas

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Are you interested in receiving a contract with the State of Arkansas? You may consider attending the monthly Vendor Class at the State of Arkansas' Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) Procurement office. The first Wednesday of every month they teach a class on "Doing Business with the State of Arkansas" from 9am – 12pm in Little Rock. You can sign up for the free [Vendor Class](#) . Participants are provided with information on state procurement regulations as well as procedures and general information for bid submissions.

The monthly course covers:

- Registration steps a vendor must take with the State of Arkansas,
- Bidding on state contracts,
- Caution to vendors,
- Bid protests,
- Office of State Procurement website overview, and
- Minority owned business procurement opportunities.

- Hand-held and walk-through metal detectors for the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville Athletic Department, advertised at the University of Arkansas' HOGBID Solicitation Page, and
- A general contract for all labor, material and equipment for Garvan Woodland Gardens tree house, located at Hot Springs National Park, advertised by the U of A Facilities Management Planning Group.
