Adaptability is essential, as you will be serving the varied religious, spiritual, educational, and emotional needs of PCS members, and acting as a liaison to the larger community. This is an opportunity to foster a congregation that will develop along with you.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Bimah, Pastoral, and Community Duties

- Lead regular religious services, including b'nei mitzvah and holidays
- Provide spiritual and emotional support to members
- Provide bikkur cholim, shiva, and bereavement support for community members
- Opportunities for life-cycle events
- Encourage a sense of community within the congregation
- Create an inviting atmosphere for new families, including interfaith and non-practicing community members
- Represent our congregation in the community at large

Education: Hebrew School, B'nei Mitzvah, and Conversion Instruction

- Work with Educational Director to support religious school and plan/run special event and holiday programs
- Lead weekly Tefillah for Hebrew School students
- Work with B'nei Mitzvah students (a separate tutor is involved one-on-one with the students for B'nei Mitzvah preparation)
- Mentor and counsel conversion candidates
- Provide educational programs to the congregation

Administrative Duties

- Prepare Rabbi's Report for monthly board meetings
