 - There are few people today anywhere more knowledgeable about what is going on in Israel, the West Bank, and Gaza, as well as the surrounding region, than Nickolay Mladenov. In his role, Mladenov is in a unique position to engage with all the parties on every level from political to humanitarian. AJC has known him for many years, beginning with his tenure as foreign minister of Bulgaria, when he became a close friend, and his appearance at the AJC Global Forum. Mr. Mladenov will assess the latest developments in the region

during the pandemic and three months after President Trump unveiled a detailed “Vision for Peace.”
