



Lunch & Learn: Surviving and Remembering – The Untold Story of the 222 Transport Holocaust Survivors

In honor of **Yom Hashoah**, this presentation explores a little-known chapter of the Holocaust—the remarkable story of 222 Jewish prisoners who survived through a rare prisoner exchange in July 1944. Known as the “**222 Transport**,” the exchange involved inmates from the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp who were traded for members of the German Templer community living in Palestine.

Central to this story is the experience of **Monika Jalili**’s family, particularly her father, who was just ten years old at the time. The program will examine the historical context of the exchange while also sharing Monika’s family story—their lives during the war, their survival, and the path they forged afterward.
