

Dear Resilient Georgia Regional Coalition Leader,

We are so pleased to share another opportunity to bring HOPE GIVERS LIVE! to rural school communities in Georgia for the 2025-2026 school year. The Pittulloch Foundation, Connected Content and the HOPE GIVERS Team, and Resilient Georgia has partnered to offer HOPE GIVERS LIVE! at a **50% discounted cost** to rural, public schools and Regional Coalitions. At this discounted rate, schools would only have to pay an estimated \$2,625-\$3,600 depending on the region of the state. For the purposes of this opportunity, rural schools are defined as schools in counties **outside of the 20-county Metro Atlanta Area.** Check out their **EMMY AWARD WINNING Episode** to learn more about their work!

A HOPE GIVERS LIVE! Event will serve as an entry point to accessing the free suite of HOPE GIVERS materials and will also help deepen coalition partnerships in rural communities, serving as an intro duction or reintroduction to coalition resources including trauma-informed trainings and a network of local and statewide

partners working towards policy, systems, and environmental change. Connections to HOPE GIVERS and Regional Coalition resources can help schools build a supportive culture for both staff and students. Organizing a HOPE GIVERS LIVE! Event can also help identify new coalition members and forge partnerships with rural schools and community organizations.

The HOPE GIVERS Team will:

- · Participate in planning meetings with Regional Coalition leaders and school staff.
- Co-present during a one-hour **Resource Roundtable.** The HOPE GIVERS team will share their free on-line resources with recommendations on how to align the materials with school curriculum and after school programming.
- Provide a HOPE GIVERS LIVE event.
- Collect data directly from students via QR codes at the end of the event and conduct follow-up surveys or evaluations
 with staff and educators to gather insights on the effectiveness of the materials and identify opportunities for
 improvement.
- Compile and disseminate the collected data to all partners to ensure transparency and informed decision-making. **Regional Coalition Leaders will:**
 - Facilitate introductions and meetings with school leaders and HOPE GIVERS LIVE Team to plan the HOPE GIVERS LIVE
 event and a one-hour Resource Roundtable. Planning meetings will acquaint school leadership with the full scope of
 materials that both HOPE GIVERS and Regional Coalitions offer and will also help identify school representatives for the
 Roundtable.
 - Lead a one-hour **Resource Roundtable** which will include HOPE GIVERS team members and key representatives from the school community (including but not limited to administration, school counselors, school nurses, health teachers, school nutrition staff, and PTA). This Roundtable is an opportunity to share more about your regional coalition, highlight trauma-informed and resiliency building trainings and resources that can support school staff and students, and identify action steps to continue partnering after the event.
 - Promote the HOPE GIVERS LIVE event through social media channels and network and share with <u>Alex English</u> to promote through Resilient Georgia channels.
 - Attend and support the HOPE GIVERS LIVE event
 - Provide a summary of your activities including photos and number of participants after the HOPE GIVERS LIVE Event and Resource Roundtable. We want to highlight and elevate all your work!
 - Optional: Support school leaders in identifying funding sources or sponsorship opportunities to help cover a portion of the remaining cost of the HOPE GIVERS LIVE! Event.
