Eligibility

- Based in Georgia or serving Georgia communities.
- Align with the goals of community healing and addressing systemic injustices.



Priority Consideration

- BIPOC individuals or organizations.
- BIPOC-led organizations (51% or
- Organizations with operating budgets under \$50,000.
- Projects driven by hope, executed with community involvement, and rooted in resilience.



How to Apply

- **Proposal:** Submit a 1-2 page proposal including a group bio, project summary, timeline, and budget / spending plan. You may submit an optional letter of support.
- **Submission:** Email your proposal to truth@civilandhumanrights.org by January 15, 2025.
