

REGIONAL COALITIONS

Resilient Georgia is made up of a network of diverse, robust and well-planned public-private partnerships with a regional behavioral health focus. These 18 regional coalitions are deeply engaged in their work to reduce mental health stigma, prevent and heal childhood adversity, emphasize trauma-informed awareness and care, and promote resilience in children and their families.

To lead a state-wide coalition to develop a closely-aligned and trauma-informed public and private network working toward a united vision to create a birth through 26 year old integrated behavioral health system. Key components to be implemented by our partners include prevention, early intervention, research, advocacy and policy, and System of Care implementation and coordination.

Every child and young adult in Georgia will have access to highquality, integrated behavioral health services and support, empowered by a statewide network of trauma-informed organizations working together to prevent and heal childhood adversity.
