

PARENTAL PERMISSION ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION BY SCHOOL PERSONNEL 2020-2021

We encourage parents to work with their doctor to use medication that does not have to be administered at school. If a student must bring medication to school, the medication <u>must be in its original container along with doctor's instructions on distribution to the child</u>. The student may not have any medication, prescription or otherwise, cough drops or aspirin on his/her person. All medication will be properly stored in the office/clinic under lock and key and must be distributed from the office/clinic. Over the counter medication must also be in its original container and a parental authorization letter must be on file in the office/clinic.

There shall be no liability for civil damages as a result of the administration of such medication when the person administering such medication acts as an ordinarily reasonably prudent person would have acted under the same or similar circumstances.
