Program Overview:

Northwell Health's Staten Island University Hospital is proud to offer a paid, comprehensive program, in partnership with our Military Liaison Services Department, to support eligible veterans and active service members who want to jump-start a career to become a patient care associate.

The Train and Earn Patient Care Associate Program is a six-to-eight-week, full-time, onthe-job, paid training course designed for eligible veterans and active service members to receive didactic and experiential learning as a patient care associate. Northwell Health is providing a full scholarship to all who participate in this training program.

Upon successful completion of the Train and Earn Patient Care Associate Program, each participant has an opportunity to be promoted to a full-time patient care associate.

- Have earned a state-endorsed high school diploma or HSE/TASC (formerly GED certificate).
- Pass a background check.
- Provide an employment commitment to work as a patient care associate at Northwell for at least one year, upon successful completion of the program.
