PARENT-TEACHER LEAGUE (PTL)

The PTL is an organization of school parents, teachers, and friends who are committed to enriching our students' academic, social, and spiritual education at Family of Christ Christian School. One of the primary functions of the PTL is to organize fundraising. Elected officers and the principal meet regularly. An annual contribution of \$50.00 per family is collected as funds for supportive activities and program enhancements that benefit the entire student body.

PARENT-TEACHER LEAGUE VOLUNTEER HOURS

Every family attending Family of Christ Christian School is required to perform 20 hours of volunteer work annually or to pay \$12.50 per volunteer hour for shortage at the end of the school year. The PTL sends every family a quarterly statement.

All families are responsible for recording their completed hours electronically through a system called Signup Genius. Families receive access to this website by email at the beginning of the school year.

Monetary donations do not count toward volunteer hours.
