Consideration for any scholarship award is based on a point system including GPA, participation in extra-curricular activities, school organizations and community service. This will be a four-year scholarship, and you must maintain criteria set in the guidelines listed in this application

Purpose: To support graduating high school seniors related to active members of Knights of Columbus Council 10852 in their efforts to prepare themselves educationally for future vocations enabling them to be financially independent of their parents, strong Catholic adults and able to be gainful citizens.

Award. The typical award is one scholarship per year and is valued at \$500.00 per year for four years. The scholarship is paid directly to the institution for student expenses. The scholarship does not have to be renewed as long as the student continues the required contact with the Council and service to his or her parish.

Who can apply?

- Must be a graduating high school senior in the year the scholarship is offered or has graduated from high school, taken a GAP year and is now ready to attend a four-year accredited college.

- Must be the son or daughter, grandson or granddaughter or brother or sister of a Knight in good standing member of Council 10852.
- The student must be a confirmed Catholic
- The student must be seeking to obtain a professional or trade certification accepted by the scholarship board from an accredited institution, or an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution.
- The student shall have shown him or herself to have been a practicing Catholic, who has been a successful high school student and active in the community.
- The student must accept the basic tenants of the Catholic Church.
- The student shall provide appropriate indications that he or she will be successful in the academic endeavors for which the Council will be supporting them.

Student requirements

- Students are expected to be forthright and honest in their written presentations
- Students should be prepared and communicate with the Board if any changes occur.
- Scholarship recipients will be asked to continue to stay in touch with the Council during the time they receive financial support to keep them informed of any changes in their status.
