Coyote Activity

Coyotes can be seen any time of day but are most active at dusk, nighttime and dawn.



An Animal Control Officer will respond to coyote calls if the coyote is sick, injured or if there is an attack or threatening behavior toward a person or pet.

If a coyote is posing an imminent threat to life, call 9-1-1.

Residents are reminded to follow safeguards to protect pets and property against coyotes.



HOW TO COEXIST WITH COYOTES



Do not feed wildlife



Keep pets and pet food inside



Keep your pet on a leash



Do not leave rotten fruit on the ground



Put waste in trash containers with tight-fitting lids

HOW TO "HAZE" COYOTES — SAFELY SCARING A COYOTE AWAY TO MAINTAIN ITS NATURAL FEAR OF PEOPLE.



Use a whistle



Bang on pots and pans



Stomp your feet



Never run from a coyote



Throw rocks and tennis balls towards the coyote



Use a water hose or pepper spray
