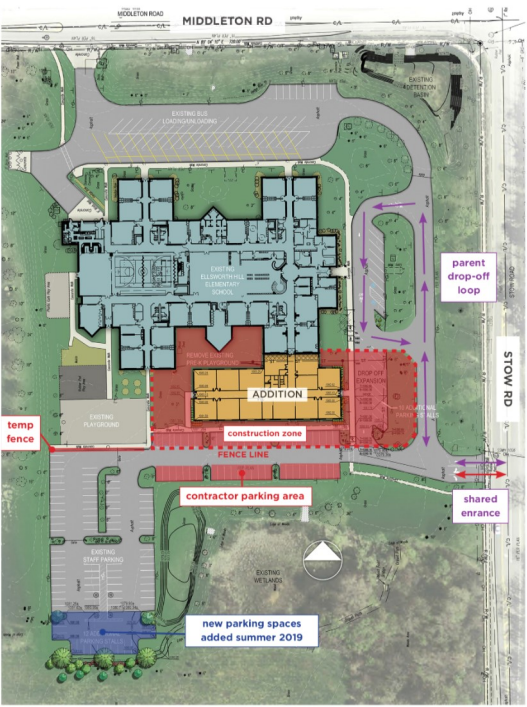
## ELLSWORTH HILL ELEMENTARY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE AND FENCE LINE MAP

Hammond Construction will begin mobilizing on site in mid to late May for the new 14,000 square foot classroom addition to Ellsworth Hill Elementary School. The single story addition will include 11 additional classrooms to accommodate grades 1-2 starting the 2020-2021 school year.

Construction fencing will be placed around the perimeter of the work site for site safety and security. The fence will be in place starting this May and will remain through the course of the project until completion in the summer of 2020. During the summer of 2019, construction crews will focus on accomplishing the heavy construction work while the school campus is vacated. This includes additional parking spaces, re-stripping of the back parking lot, and commencement of steel erection, exterior walls and roof of the addition.

All construction workers will be background checked and required to meet stringent safety standards while on the job site. Furthermore, contractors will never be working inside of the existing school while children are in session during the school day.

The parent and visitor drop-off loop and all traffic patterns that are currently followed on site will remain in place through construction. It is important to note that the entrance from Stow Road onto the school site will be a shared entrance for parents, staff and construction workers; however, we anticipate this will have minimal impact to the traffic heavy portions of the school day.

On Monday, February 11, 2019, the Board of Education approved a resolution to accept the lowest responsible and responsive bid of Engelke Construction Solutions, LLC for the Ada Cooper Miller Natatorium additions and renovations and the East Woods Locker Room Renovation.

The Natatorium is included in the Master Facility Plan. Additional monies from HCER will provide for the East Woods locker room renovations, and the District will replace the aging roof and HVAC system with Permanent Improvement Funds. The PI funds were previously allocated to replace the roof and HVAC over this portion of the Natatorium.

The Natatorium is heavily used by the District for HHS Swimming and Diving teams, student swimming lessons as part of the 4 & 5th grade PE program, Safety Town swimming lessons, community public swim sessions, and the HEAT youth swimming program through HCER.

Renovations began in March 2019. The approximate completion date of the project is January 1, 2020.
