he brought Nathanael to Jesus

JUDAS

(Mark 3:19)

a Cananaean (Canaanite)

A WAY TO REMEMBER THE NAMES OF THE DISCIPLES

An easy way to remember the disciples' names is to create a mnemonic. For example, **STAMP** the **T**(oast) with **P**(eanut) **B**(utter) and **4 J**(ams) stands for:

Thaddaeus

Andrew

Matthew

Philip

Thomas

Peter

Bartholomew

John

James
