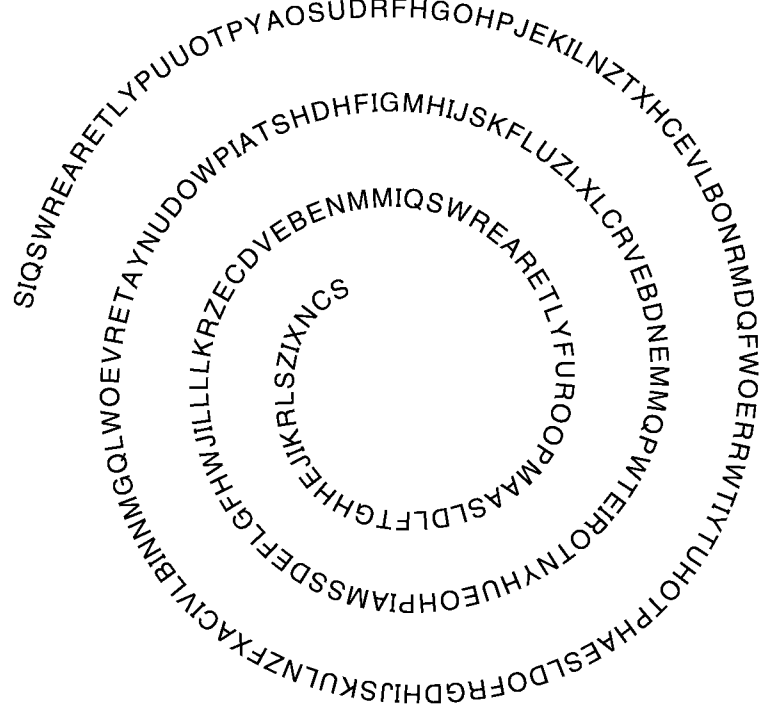

Find the 12 differences in the second picture.



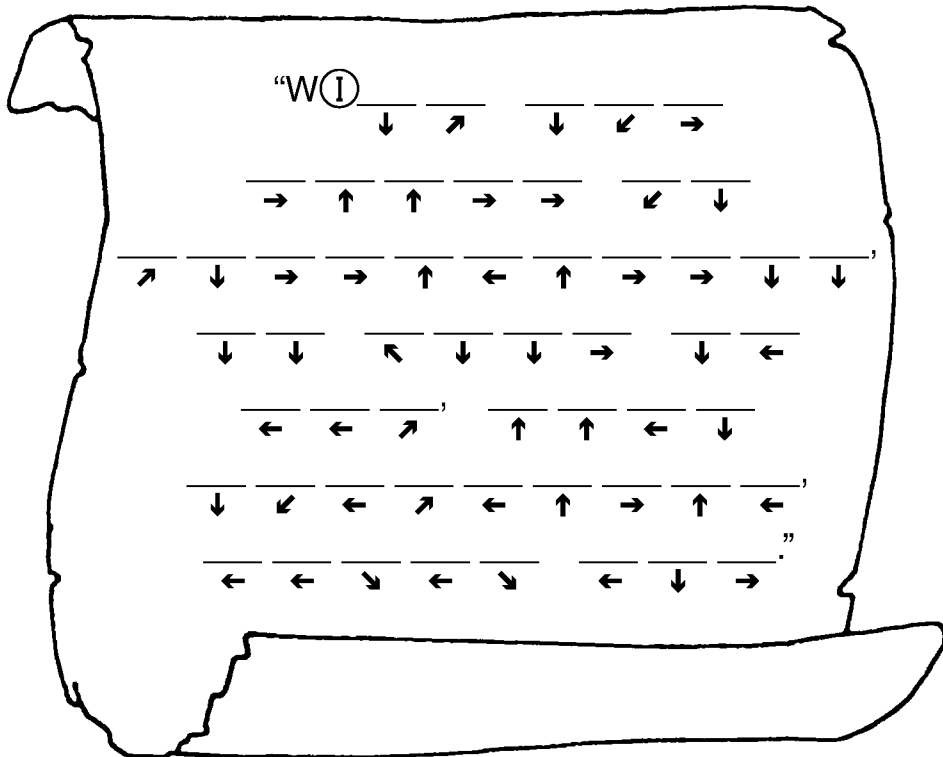

Follow the arrow directions beneath the blanks to write the letters in order and find out.

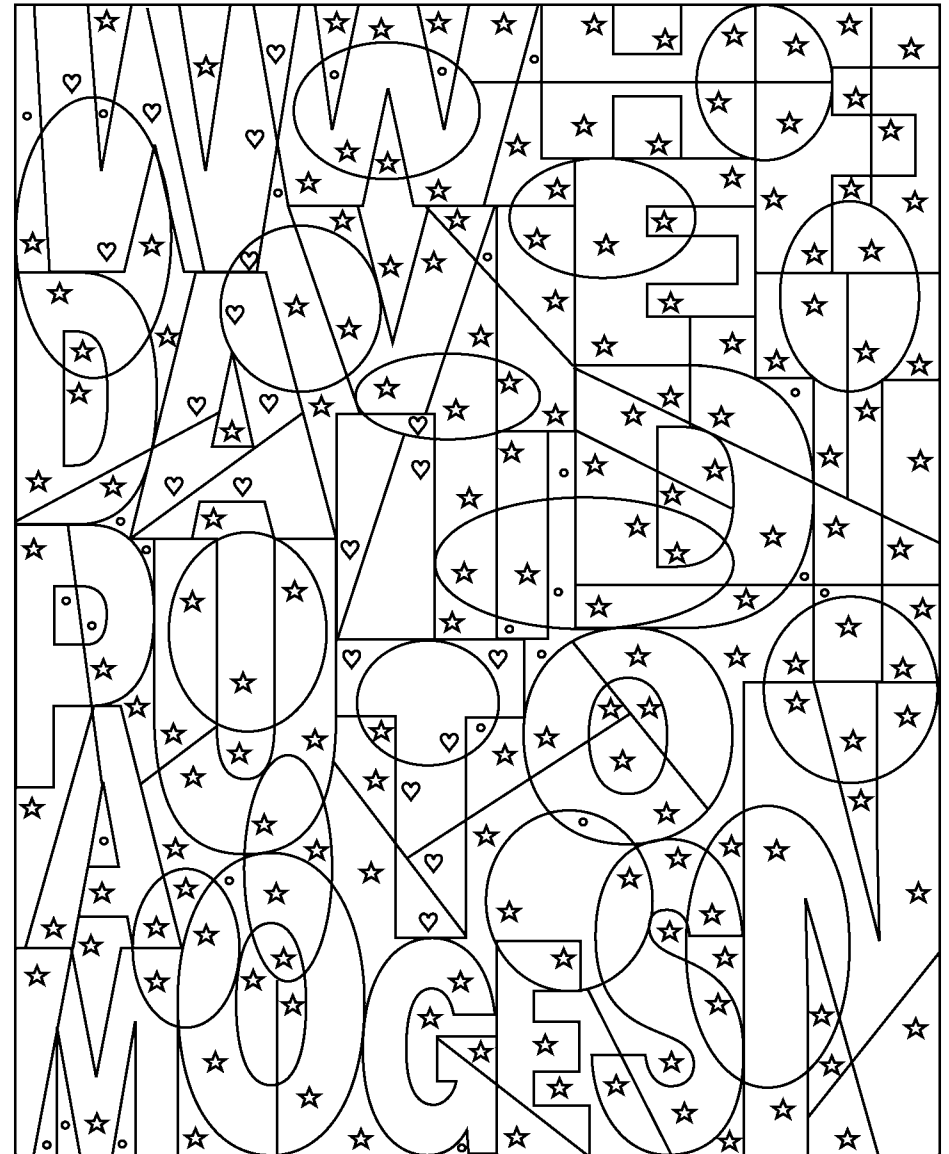
