Rabbi Karol will talk about Judaism and the supernatural, relate some of the stories he's collected from family and friends, and invite participants to share their stories. "Signs" include: a sense of the presence of the deceased, contact through dreams, certain numbers appearing repeatedly, significant music playing suddenly, long-lost objects being found, continuous "visits" by animals, orbs in photos, and inexplicable electric and electronic problems.

Rabbi Stephen A. Karol is Rabbi Emeritus of Temple Isaiah in Stony Brook, New York. He was ordained at the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion (HUC-JIR) in Cincinnati in 1977, and has served at Temple Beth Zion in Buffalo, New York, Congregation Sha'aray Shalom in Hingham, Massachusetts, and Temple Isaiah. He teaches at Temple Isaiah and also at the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at Stony Brook University. Rabbi Karol lives in Port Jefferson Station, New York with his wife Donna.
