**Fuller Description of Services:** Belev Echad walks with wounded IDF soldiers through every phase of recovery, offering long-term, comprehensive care that meets their emotional, physical, social, and financial needs. Our services include trauma counseling, medical navigation, career guidance, mentorship, educational support, and emergency financial assistance, and family care initiatives assuring that every soldier and their family has the tools to rebuild confidence, purpose, and stability.

At our Kiryat Ono home in Israel, soldiers access a full continuum of care through over 18 targeted programs. Our **medical therapies** include physiotherapy, occupational therapy, facial therapy, and Watsu therapy. Our **non-medical programs** span food assistance, service and therapeutic dogs, martial arts, gym training, and educational counseling. The house welcomes more than **200 soldiers every day**, offering daily living assistance, communal meals, emotional support, and a warm, family-like environment. It is a place where soldiers heal, regain independence, and build community with peers who truly understand their journey.

In 2024:

- 1,200 food aid packages delivered to soldiers and their families
- 18,000 meals served at the Belev Echad House, creating a true sense of community
- 200 soldiers daily find therapies, programs, and community at the Belev Echad House
- 43 soldiers received advanced prosthetics and life changing surgeries
- 100 soldiers received therapeutic & service dogs that save lives and restore purpose
