1) Place items in your back alley no later than **8AM (do not block the path of travel)** or

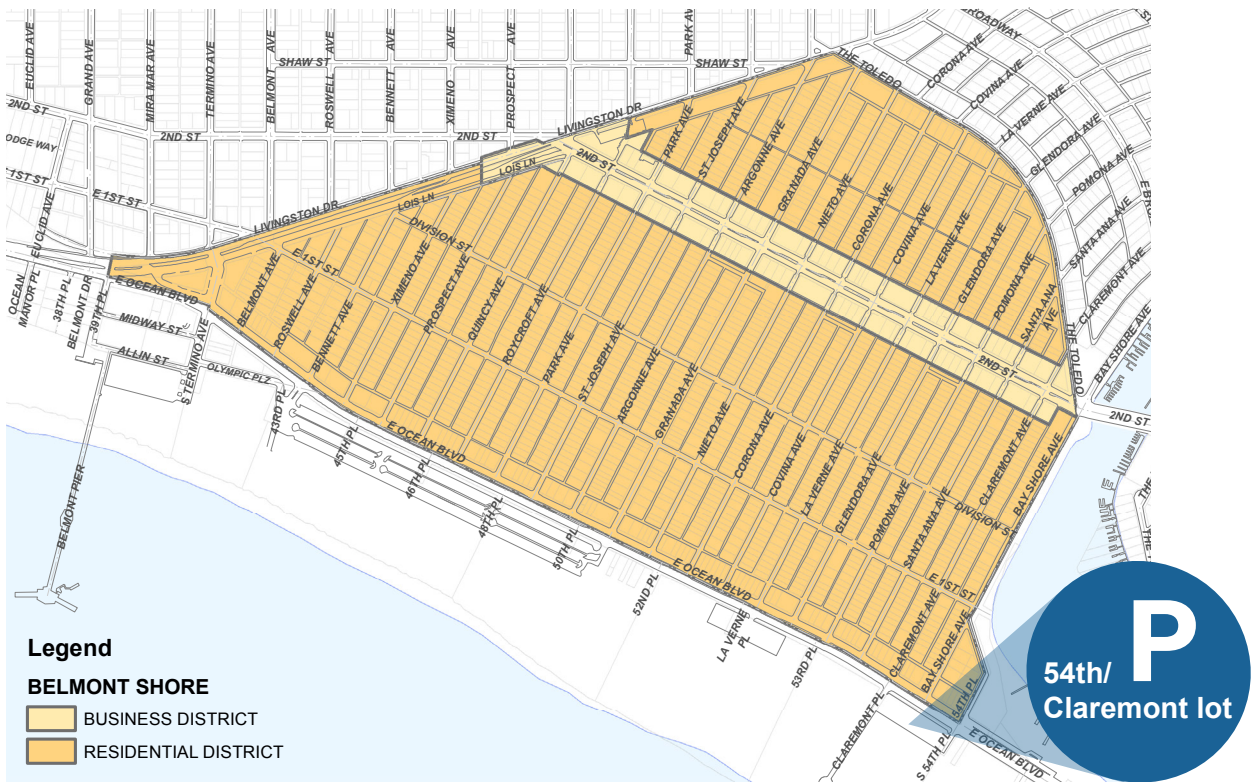
2) Drop off items at the 54th / Claremont lot seen in map below.

Description: In response to the Belmont Shore community’s parking challenges, the City of Long Beach is partnering with the Salvation Army to collect items that typically take up space in garages. As a reminder, garages should be used for the purpose of parking vehicles. If you would like to receive a donation receipt from Salvation Army, items must be dropped off at the 54th / Claremont lot.
