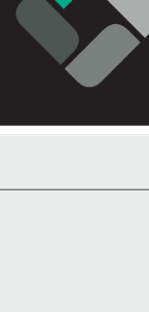

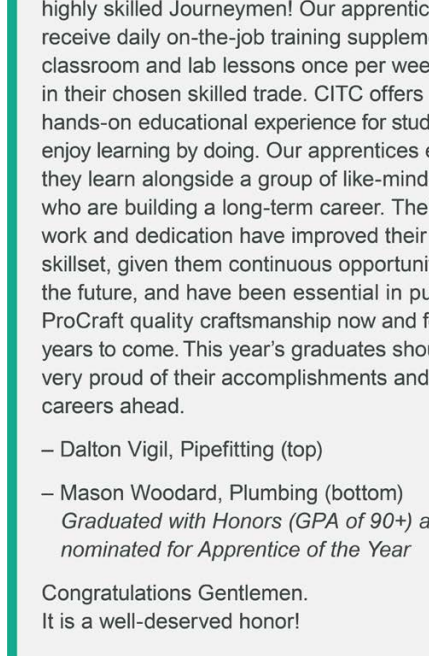

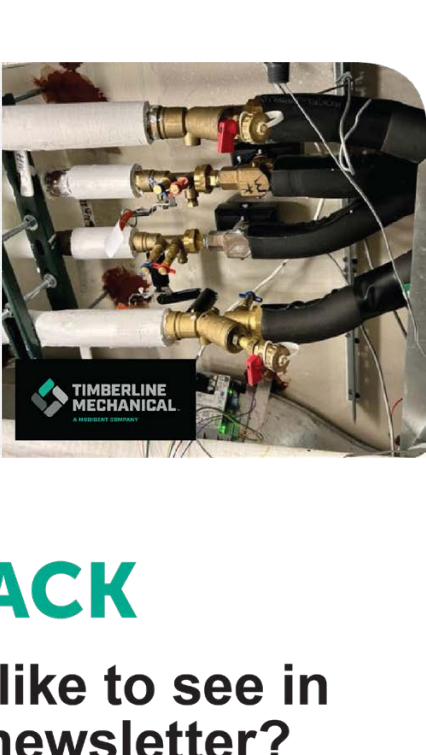
2023 CITC Spring Graduates

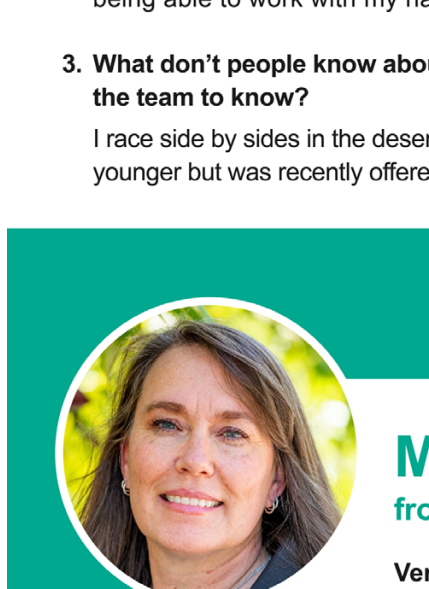

Salt Palace De-Aeration Tank Project

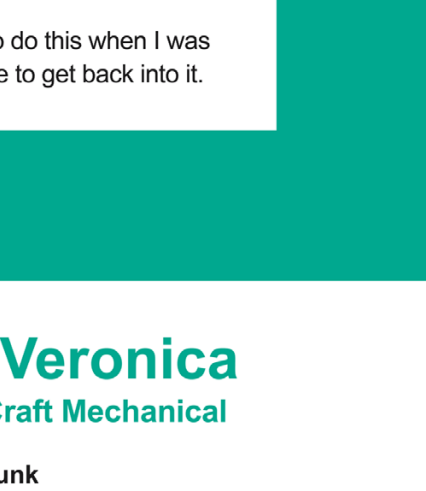

The Salt Palace, an iconic venue known for hosting many events and exhibitions, entrusted our company with this crucial undertaking. Our team fully embraced the challenge and committed to executing the project within a strict shutdown timeframe. Our crew's seamless coordination and unwavering determination throughout the process allowed us to accomplish the project's objectives efficiently and to the highest standards.

From the initial planning stages to the final touches, every project step demanded meticulous attention to detail and precise execution. Removing and replacing the de-aeration tank required our professionals to navigate complex piping systems, ensuring optimal functionality and compliance with safety regulations. With careful coordination and effective communication, our team adeptly managed potential obstacles, guaranteeing minimal disruption to Salt Palace's operations.



Service Retrofit at the University of Colorado

We are working on a Service Retrofit project for the University of Colorado at the Bear Creek student housing in Boulder. We are replacing blower motors, blower wheels, isolation valves, control valves, and y strainers on over 200 HW/CW Fan Coil Units. This is a super quick turnaround project, which requires great planning and coordination to complete in a 4-week window of time.



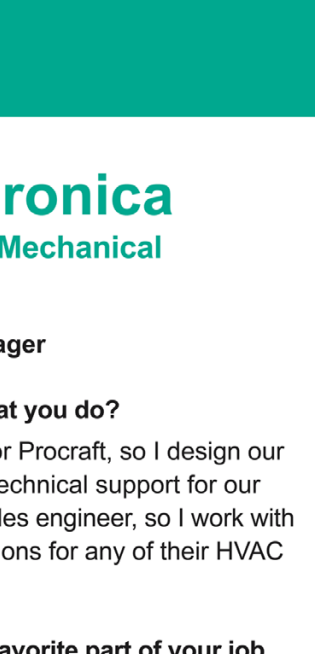

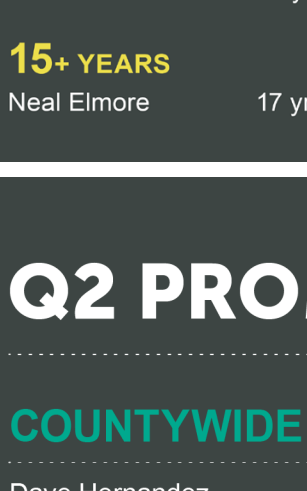
Meet Hunter from Countywide Mechanical

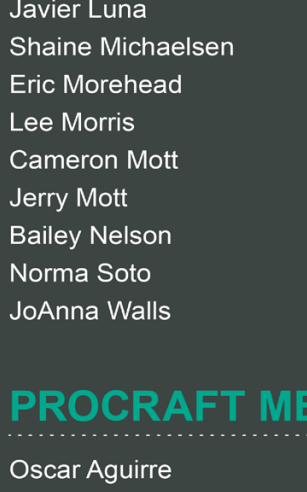
Meet Patrick from Rocky Mountain Mechanical
