ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY/ DEVICES

Schedules, calendars, timers

Tablet, webcam, hotspot, etc for telehealth or meetings, communication support

Visual schedules

Small printer/ink for visuals, communication support

Bed/chair positioning devices

Apps for communication support

PERSONAL CARE/ INDEPENDENCE

Personal hygiene wipes/Bidet

Support for dressing (ie long handle shoe horn, button hooks, etc)

Electric toothbrush

Adaptive Equipment - kitchen, bath, etc

Detachable shower head

Alarms

SENSORY

Indoor trampoline, jump rope, etc

Sensory play - Water/Sand/Shaving cream

Weighted blanket

Chewies, fidgets, wobbly chair

Therapy Swing (indoors)

Headphones

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Professional behavior services (telemedicine)

Supports for sitting and sleeping

Video monitoring alarms

Mobility/Transitioning Support

Medication management, Cabinet locks

Seizure monitoring tools

EMOTIONAL REGULATION

Things to keep my hands busy; gardening, art, games, etc



Things to keep me calm; reading, puzzles, relaxation tools, etc



Things to move my body; yoga balls & mats, bands, etc
